

# NOTICE ABOUT 2020 TAX RATES

Property Tax Rates in Ector County Hospital District

This notice concerns the 2020 property tax rates for Ector County Hospital District. This notice provides information about two tax rates. The no-new-revenue tax rate would impose the same amount of taxes as last year if you compare properties taxed in both years. The voter-approval tax rate is the highest tax rate a taxing unit can adopt without holding an election. In each case, these rates are calculated by dividing the total amount of taxes by the current taxable value with adjustments as required by state law. The rates are given per \$100 of property value.

**This year's no-new-revenue tax rate:** \$0.114092

**This year's voter-approval tax rate:** \$0.236170

## Enhanced Indigent Health Care Expenditures

**The Ector County Hospital District spent 3,456,091 from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020 on expenditures to maintain and operate an eligible county hospital. For the current tax year, the amount of increase above last year's eligible county hospital expenditures is \$187,328.. This increased the no-new-revenue tax rate by \$0.001173.**
